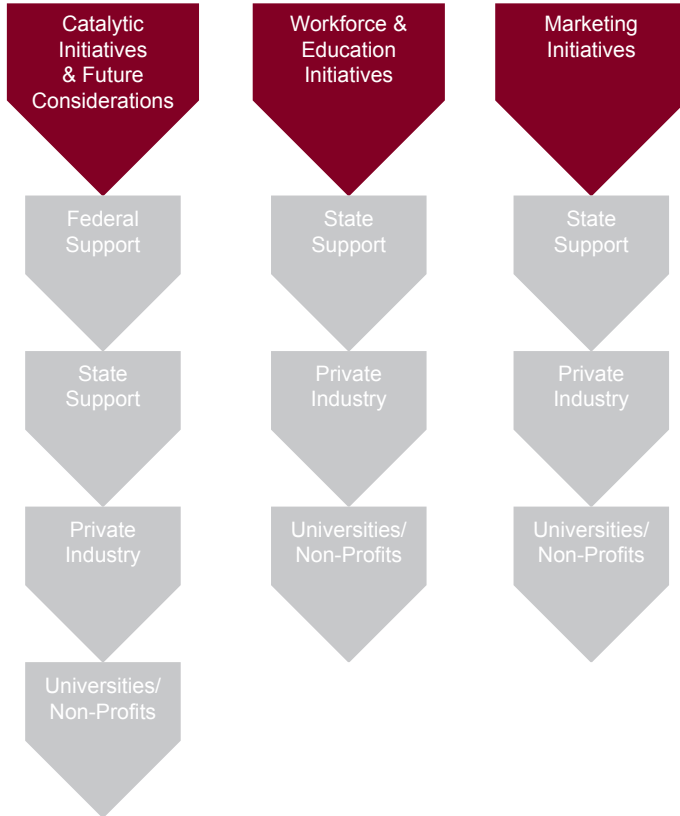


Implementation for Success: Key Steps

Five Core Focus Areas

- Review competitive incentive and investment policies
- Pursue controlled unmanned systems airspace
- Create an Unmanned Systems Center of Excellence
- Evaluate unmanned systems attraction package
- Encourage universities to support Unmanned Systems courses
- Outreach to advanced material development leaders
- Incent use of R&D/Testing facilities
- Coordinate the state's bio fuels efforts
- Fund an analysis of MRO requirements/gaps
- Identify broker companies
- Create consortium to support NextGen
(NextGen represents the FAA Next Generation Air Transportation System)
- Support coalition on exploration of Ohio Center for Business Aviation

Medium-Term Initiatives

Five Core Focus Areas

- Establish Executive Branch Oversight and Legislative Advocacy Program to influence federal expenditures
- Maintain positive labor-management relations

- Secure funding/sources for Unmanned Systems
- Capitalize on regional investment in US modeling and simulation
- Increase outreach/delegation efforts to OEMs
- Increase Third Frontier funding for advanced materials
- Create a mentor protégé program for advanced materials development
- Remove barriers to Ohio labs
- Create the Ohio CLEEN program
- Build the business case and business development plan to support Plum Brook Station Runway
- Market Ohio's R&D/Testing capabilities
