



**FY 2009 Ohio Small Cities
Community Development Block Grant
Economic Development Program
Award Recipients**

In FY 2009, the Ohio Department of Development's Office of Housing and Community Partnerships awarded nine Ohio Small Cities Community Development Block Grant Economic Development Program grants totaling \$2,694,200 to local governments in Ohio. As a result, approximately 251 jobs will be created, 57 jobs will be retained and more than \$31.7 million of other public and private funds will be leveraged.
