



**FY 2009
Water and Sanitary Sewer Program
Award Recipients**

In FY 2009, the Ohio Department of Development's Office of Housing and Community Partnerships awarded 22 Water and Sanitary Sewer Program grants totaling \$9,944,800 to install 334,393 linear feet of water and sewer line, construct/rehabilitate seven water and sewer facilities; provide tap-ins for 476 households; assist more than 13,700 persons; and leverage more than \$43.5 million.
