SUBJECT: Letter of Interest for Program Year 2014 Residential Public Infrastructure Grant Program Funding

Communities interested in submitting an application for the Program Year 2014 Community Development Block Grant Residential Public Infrastructure Grant (RPIG) program must submit a Letter of Interest to the Office of Community Development. The Letter of Interest must include:

- A brief description of the proposed project and project area;
- A summary of other funds committed to the project;
- A copy of the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (OEPA) Permit to Install or Plan Approval, if applicable;
- A brief description of the community's current water and wastewater systems;
- Name, address, telephone number and email address of the community's Chief Elected Official; and
- Name, address, telephone number and email address of the community's grant writer.

The Office of Community Development will send eligible communities instructions on how to complete the online application. Communities that are not eligible to apply directly for funding will receive more information regarding how to coordinate an application with their county of jurisdiction. *Access to the online application does not guarantee funding.* The Office of Community Development also will notify communities that are not eligible to apply for RPIG funding.
