Grant Improves Water System in Village of Deshler

The village of Deshler (Henry County) will receive a grant to improve its water treatment system. The grant is through the Residential Public Infrastructure Program and funded by the Community Development Block Grant.

The village will receive a \$500,000 grant to install a larger capacity lift station and 7,250 linear feet of force main to the wastewater treatment facility. An additional lagoon will be constructed to handle overflow during heavy rains. The improvements will benefit 694 households in the area.

“Reliable and safe water is integral to maintaining and strengthening communities in Ohio,” said David Goodman, director of the Ohio Development Services Agency.

The Residential Public Infrastructure Program is administered by the Ohio Development Services Agency’s Office of Community Development.
