NOTES:

METROPOLITAN STATISTICAL AREAS:

Have at least one urbanized area of 50,000 or more population, plus adjacent territory that has a high degree of social and economic integration with the core as measured by commuting ties.

MICROPOLITAN STATISTICAL AREAS:

A new set of statistical areas - have at least one urban cluster of at least 10,000 but less than 50,000 population, plus adjacent territory that has a high degree of social and economic integration with the core as measured by commuting ties,

METROPOLITAN and MICROPOLITAN STATISTICAL AREAS are defined in terms of whole counties.

COMBINED STATISTICAL AREAS:

Groupings of two or more adjacent Metropolitan or Micropolitan Statistical Areas when employment interchange exceeds 15%

PRINCIPAL CITIES:

Replaces 'CENTRAL CITY', the term used in previous standards and is the geography used in naming the area.

Cities listed in the table are the designated principal cities.

Population for the counties are 2002 estimates and cities are the 2000 census counts
