CLEAN OHIO FUND - ROUND 2 FUNDING: The capital appropriation bill providing for the second round of Clean Ohio funding has passed the Ohio legislature.

House Bill No. 675 includes \$37.5 million dollars for the Clean Ohio Conservation Program as well as \$6.25million for recreational trails, \$6.25 million for farmland preservation and \$50 million for brownfield revitalization. The bill becomes effective 90 days after being signed by the Governor which is anticipated to allow the Clean Ohio programs to move forward early in the second quarter of 2003.

Round 2 Clean Ohio Conservation Fund allocations to each of the nineteen Natural Resources Assistance Councils are attached.

Application materials and individual NRAC deadlines and project selection methodologies will be posted on the Clean Ohio feature of the Commission's web site <www.pwc.state.oh.us> as received.

Each Natural Resources Assistance Council must provide the Commission with any changes to their project selection methodology for its approval in advance of calling for applications. Councils must allow a minimum of sixty days from their call for applications for applications to be received.

Natural Resources Assistance Councils may submit selected projects to the Commission between April 1, 2003 and June 30, 2003.

The Commission will review and release approved projects on a first in, first out basis.
