To construct the first 1 mile segment of the Riverfront Heritage Recreational Trail starting in  
To develop 1.25 miles of trail, bridge deck and repair on bridge, this is phase 1 of the  
To acquire approximately 8.6 acres of unused railway and construct a paved pedestrian &  
Acquiring 1.67 acres necessary to develop the O'Malley Henninger Greenway trail that will  
Construct a one mile all purpose trail on the eastside of the Richmond Rd. (OH175) from the  
To develop an 10ft wide, 2 miles asphalt concrete surface trail, with 4ft berms the trail will start
