Enclosed are the original and four copies of the ***FY 2010 Ohio Consolidated Plan Amendment/Action Plan for the Neighborhood Stabilization Program (NSP) 3***. The Ohio Department of Development (ODOD) appreciates receiving an \$11,795,818 million NSP 3 allocation and looks forward to working with the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) throughout the implementation process. ODOD plans to allocate the funds to the Ohio Housing Finance Agency, through a subrecipient agreement, to improve rental housing opportunities for individuals and families with income at or below 50 percent of the area median income in the targeted Ohio Census tracts listed in the amendment.

To ensure citizen participation during the public comment period, ODOD published notification of the public comment period on the department's website and direct mailed the notification to approximately 1,100 interested persons. The 15-day comment period on the amendment began on February 3, 2011 and ended on February 18, 2011. A summary of the comments received is included in the enclosed document.
