The **Ohio Consolidated Plan** governs distributing approximately \$68 million in federal funds from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD), including funds from the following programs:

- Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Program
- HOME Investment Partnerships Program
- Emergency Solutions Grant (ESG) Program
- Housing Opportunities for Persons With AIDS (HOPWA) Program
- National Housing Trust Fund.
