SUBJECT: PY 2019 Community Housing Impact and Preservation Program Notice of Funding Availability and Application Notification

For Program Year (PY) 2019, the Ohio Development Services Agency's Office of Community Development (OCD) expects to allocate approximately \$25 million to the Community Housing Impact and Preservation (CHIP) Program through the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) and HOME Investment Partnerships Program. The PY 2019 CHIP Program funds will be distributed to eligible single-jurisdiction or partnership applicants in one competitive funding round.

The CHIP Program online application **submission deadline is Friday, May 3, 2019; at 11:59 p.m.** Specifications provided in the application instructions will be in effect for the PY 2019 CHIP Program grants subject to approval of the PY 2019 Consolidated Plan.
