Grant Improves Water System in Village of Caldwell

The village of Caldwell (Noble County) will receive a grant to improve the village water system. The grant is from the Community Development Block Grant, Residential Public Infrastructure Program.

The village will receive a \$500,000 grant to install approximately 18,800 linear feet of sanitary and storm sewer lines. The project will benefit 867 households in the area.

“Efficient and safe water systems are integral to providing a strong quality of life for Ohioans,” said David Goodman, director of the Ohio Development Services Agency. “Reliable infrastructure also better positions our communities for economic development.”
