Grant to Improve Water System in Harrisville Village

Harrisville Village (Harrison County) will receive a grant to help improve the water quality in the village. The grant is from the Community Development Block Grant, Residential Public Infrastructure Program.

The village will receive a \$600,000 grant to install a new wastewater collection and treatment system that includes 14,000 linear feet of sewer lines, two pump stations and construction of a wastewater treatment facility. The project will connect 47 low- and moderate-income households to the system and benefit a total of 91 households in the area.

“Access to a reliable and safe water system improves the quality of life for those living in the village,” said David Goodman, director of the Ohio Development Services Agency.

The Community Development Block Grant Program is administered by the Ohio Development Services Agency’s Office of Community Development.
