Revoldt Named to Lead Legislative Affairs for Ohio Department of Development

COLUMBUS – Former Mayor of North Canton, Daryl L. Revoldt, has been named to lead the Ohio Department of Development's Office of Legislative Affairs and Outreach, effective March 28.

"Daryl shares the vision the Governor and I have for reforming economic development through JobsOhio," said Mark D. Kvamme, Director of the Ohio Department of Development. "He's passionate about improving the state by helping communicate our vision for JobsOhio and other economic development priorities."

"I couldn't be more pleased to return to the Ohio Department of Development at such an important time," Revoldt said. "It's critical that we transform how we've been approaching economic development so we can create much-needed jobs for Ohioans."

Revoldt is the Director of Government Relations and Academic Affairs for TechniGraphics, Inc. of Wooster. He previously worked for the Ohio Department of Development as the Governor's Regional Representative in Northeast Ohio from 2001 to 2006.

From 1985 to 2001 he was District Director and District Aide to U.S. Representative Ralph Regula of Ohio's 16th District. He served as Mayor of North Canton from 1998 to 2001 and as City Council President in the mid-1990s and again in 2007 until stepping down recently to accept the position with the Ohio Department of Development. His involvement with Council began in 1981.

Revoldt holds a bachelor's and a master's degree from Miami University and a doctorate from the University of Akron.

He is a member of the Governor's Aerospace and Business Aviation Advisory Council, the Workforce Investment Board, and the Northeast Ohio Government Relations Association. He is also Vice Chair of the Wayne Economic Development Council.
