Ohio Expansion Project to Create Jobs for Ohioans

Columbus – The State Controlling Board today approved a \$50,000 Rapid Outreach Grant for HealthSpot, Inc. The grant, administered by the Ohio Department of Development, is expected to help create 60 jobs, leveraging more than \$1.7 million in additional investment in the state.

HealthSpot, Inc. is located in the City of Dublin (Franklin County) and assists healthcare providers in extending their reach to retailers, employers, nursing homes, community centers, and other outlets to better keep their customers informed. The company has created a patent-protected healthcare station that enables customers to stay in contact more frequently with locally and nationally recognized healthcare providers for healthcare information and updates. In addition to the acquisition of new servers and related equipment, the company will locate its research and development facility, as well as its headquarters in the City of Dublin.
