Deadline Approaching for Free Summer Opportunity

The deadline for students to apply for the *2015 Appalachian Regional Commission/Oak Ridge National Laboratory Summer Math-Science-Technology Institute* is **March 13, 2015**. Application materials must be submitted directly to the Governor's Office of Appalachia and postmarked no later than **March 13, 2015**.

All Ohio Appalachian middle school and high school students interested in math, science and technology are encouraged to apply. The Institute will take place at Oak Ridge National Laboratory in Oak Ridge, Tennessee, from July 11-24, 2015 for high school students and July 19-24, 2015, for middle school students.

Middle school participants must be between 12 and 14 years old by July 19, 2015. High school participants must be at least 16 years old by July 11, 2015. Students will be chaperoned 24 hours a day, and the Institute will cover all expenses, which include meals, lodging and all means of transportation. Appalachian high school teachers (grades 9-12) in the math, science and technology fields are also eligible to apply and will receive a stipend for their participation.
