State Helps Improve Waterline in West Salem

The village of West Salem (Wayne County) received a grant to replace the Main Street waterline, which has experienced breaks. The grant is through the Residential Public Infrastructure Program and funded by the Community Development Block Grant.

The village received a \$290,000 grant to install approximately 4,440 linear feet of waterline. The project will benefit 565 households in the area.

“Reliable and safe water systems are integral to providing Ohioans with a strong quality of life,” said David Goodman, director of the Ohio Development Services Agency.

The Residential Public Infrastructure Program is administered by the Ohio Development Services Agency’s Office of Community Development.
