State Helps Improve Racine Water System

The village of Racine (Meigs County) received a grant to improve its water supply and quality. The grant is through the Community Development Block Grant Residential Public Infrastructure Program.

The village received a \$455,200 grant to make improvements to four wells and its water treatment plant. The project will benefit 337 households in the area.
