State Helps Improve Waterline in Wintersville

The village of Wintersville (Jefferson County) received a grant to replace waterline along Gumps Lane, which experiences frequent breaks. The grant is through the Community Development Block Grant Residential Public Infrastructure Program.

The village received a \$220,000 grant to install approximately 3,608 linear feet of waterline. The project will benefit 30 households in the area.

“Reliable and safe water systems are integral to providing Ohioans with a strong quality of life,” said David Goodman, director of the Ohio Development Services Agency.

The Residential Public Infrastructure Program is administered by the Ohio Development Services Agency’s Office of Community Development.
