State Helps Improve Jackson Water System

The city of Jackson (Jackson County) received a grant to make improvements to its wastewater treatment plant. The grant is through the Residential Public Infrastructure Program and funded by the Community Development Block Grant.

The city received a \$495,000 grant and the improvements will bring the plant into compliance with the National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System permit. The project will benefit 2,586 households in the area.

“Reliable and safe water systems are integral to providing Ohioans with a strong quality of life,” said David Goodman, director of the Ohio Development Services Agency.

The Residential Public Infrastructure Program is administered by the Ohio Development Services Agency’s Office of Community Development.
