State Helps Improve Village of Clarksburg Water System

The village of Clarksburg (Ross County) will receive a grant to make improvements to its water storage and distribution system. The grant is through the Residential Public Infrastructure Program and funded by the Community Development Block Grant.

The village will receive a \$300,000 grant to refurbish the water tank and replace approximately 15,400 linear feet of waterline and 210 water meters. The project will benefit 197 households in the area.

“Reliable and safe water systems are integral to providing Ohioans with a strong quality of life,” said David Goodman, director of the Ohio Development Services Agency.

The Residential Public Infrastructure Program is administered by the Ohio Development Services Agency’s Office of Community Development.
