State Helps Improve Village of Crooksville Water System

The village of Crooksville (Perry County) received a grant to make improvements to its water distribution system. The grant is through the Residential Public Infrastructure Grant Program and funded by the Community Development Block Grant.

The village received a \$600,000 grant to replace approximately 60,090 linear feet of waterline, 366 valves, and 105 fire hydrants. The village also will replace water services lines for 50 households. The project will benefit 883 households in the area.

“Reliable and safe water systems are integral to providing Ohioans with a strong quality of life,” said David Goodman, director of the Ohio Development Services Agency.

The Residential Public Infrastructure Grant Program is administered by the Ohio Development Services Agency’s Office of Community Development.
