State Helps Improve Water System in Morgan County

Morgan County will receive a grant to improve the water system for residents in the Bishopville Water District. The grant is through the Residential Public Infrastructure Program and funded by the Community Development Block Grant.

The county will receive a \$145,400 grant to install a new 100,000 gallon water storage tank and install approximately 1,535 linear feet of water line to connect the new tank to the system. The new tank will replace two older water tanks. The improvements will benefit 475 households in the area.

“Reliable and safe water systems are integral to providing Ohioans with a strong quality of life,” said David Goodman, director of the Ohio Development Services Agency.

The Residential Public Infrastructure Program is administered by the Ohio Development Services Agency’s Office of Community Development.
