Grant to Improve Water System in the Village of Polk

COLUMBUS – Ashland County will receive a grant to help the village of Polk improve its water system. The grant is from the Community Development Block Grant, Residential Public Infrastructure Program.

The county will receive a \$600,000 grant to help install a wastewater treatment and collection system in the village and will generate more than \$2.9 million of additional project funds. The project will connect 64 low- and moderate-income households to the system. The upgrades will benefit 127 households in the area.

“Access to a reliable and safe water system will improve the quality of life of people living in the village,” said David Goodman, director of the Ohio Development Services Agency.

The Community Development Block Grant Program is administered by the Ohio Development Services Agency’s Office of Community Development.
