




Brownfield Revolving Loan Fund

Project Profile:

One of a dozen grand apartment buildings that line the same block overlooking Rockefeller Park, 1341 East Boulevard is being rehabilitated by the Famicos Foundation. The building was constructed in 1910 and requires substantial upgrades and asbestos abatement to support modern living and prevent demolition. Sources of funding for the project include the Famicos Foundation, City of Cleveland, Federal Historic Tax Credits, and Dollar Bank. Famicos hopes the project will serve as a demonstration to other building owners about the potential for green historic rehabilitation projects.

Program Summary:

Provided in partnership with the U.S. EPA, the Brownfield Revolving Loan Fund offers below market rate loans to assist with the remediation of brownfield properties. Municipalities, nonprofit organizations, and private entities can apply for program funding to conduct remediation activities.
