## **Foreign Corporations With Investment in Ohio**

**September 1999**

The directory of foreign firms with investment in Ohio is a comprehensive listing of all foreign enterprises that have extensive investment or managerial interest within the State of Ohio. The report contains graphical representation of foreign firms in Ohio, followed by data sorted into four categories. The data appears in an alphabetical listing, country of parent company listing, county location listing, and Standard Industrial Code format. New to the listing this year are profiles of the premier foreign employers operating in Ohio.

This listing was created with the cooperation of foreign firms operating in the State of Ohio. Initial information was gathered through past lists, combined with corroboration from public records and newspaper and magazine articles. Verification was provided through telephone and mail surveys of management personnel at Ohio operations. There is no mandatory state filing of foreign status; thus this report was made possible through the voluntary cooperation of companies listed. Due to the voluntary nature of firm cooperation, number will differ from the United States Department of Commerce statistical totals. Companies who requested that their information not be disclosed are not listed in the directory.

When using this directory, it is important to realize that global trade and commerce is dynamic and is thus changing constantly. Ownership, location, and even operation of many of the companies listed will be subject to change. Employment counts may differ from totals published by other government sources due to aggregation, definitions, and time periods. *All information listed is current as of August 1999.*




*Graph of Locations*

# Foreign Investment in Ohio


*Graph of Employment by Country*


*Graph of Foreign Firms per County*


*Graph of Employment per County*


## *Foreign Firm Manufacturing Sector Breakdown*
