**LARGE MANUFACTURING ESTABLISHMENTS AND

Contents

These tables present statistics derived from a directory of manufacturing establishments in Ohio. The directory frequently records the number of employees at an establishment and whether it exports its products. The first table shows the distribution of the 200 largest manufacturing establishments among Ohio's 88 counties. (The actual numbers usually are greater than 200 because of ties.) The second table shows the distribution of all exporting manufacturing establishments among the counties. The establishments voluntarily provide this information—if they do not volunteer it, they are not included in the table. Information on export sales or volume is not available in this database.

Geographic Areas

Data in this report are presented for the state and the 88 counties. The larger database from which the tables are drawn offers additional information and permits production of reports by city, zip code, or area code.
