


# Population Change 1990 to 2000

\*This map shows the gain or loss of population from the 1990 Census to the 2000 Census for square cells 250 feet in size. A square mile is comprised of roughly 446 cells, so the change per square mile can be approximated by multiplying the range value by 446. The original unit for analysis is the Census tract.
