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TAXABLE VALUE OF REAL PROPERTY

Content

The following tables present the taxable value of agricultural, commercial, industrial, mineral, and residential property. The first table is a summation of the five real property categories. Under state law, taxable (i.e., assessed) value represents 35 percent of the market value, except for certain agricultural land.

County auditors classify all real property (except railroad) in Ohio into one of the five categories, depending on the property's highest or best probable use. (A second exception is "current use" for certain agricultural property). The commercial category includes public utility real property. No adjustment for inflation has been made.
