These data sets include aggregate personal income (in thousands of dollars) and per capita income for the state and 88 counties. Per capita personal income (PCI) is the total personal income of the residents of an area divided by the resident population. No adjustment for inflation has been made.

A transfer payment is a payment to a person, usually in monetary form, for which that person has not rendered a service. Examples include unemployment benefits, social security and other retirement benefits, and the value of food stamps, among other things.
